

MinnTex Citrus Grant:

The Park and Recreation Department has applied for a \$20,000 dollar grant to resurface and expand the current pickleball courts. The current courts are in rough shape with a good number of cracks running through the courts. Part of the grant process is making the courts regulation size, so we have the possibility to host sanctioned tournaments. All we have to do to be regulation sized courts is to add more room from the out of bounds lines on the sides to the fence. We currently have 4 feet of room; the grant is requiring 8 feet of room. This is also good from a safety stand point. We will have to widen the black top surface by a total 16 feet. We are also sealing the cracks and adding more blacktop on top of what is currently on the courts. That is supposed to extend the life of the courts. The estimate I received for the courts is from Heartland Asphalt for a total of \$36,500.20. With the \$20,000 grant we would only have to pay \$16,500.20. What the grant needs is a resolution for funding. The money we plan on using is from the one-day barrowing fund. The money was originally for residing the clubhouse.
