**Subject: MinnTex grant for pickle ball courts**

---

Recommendation: Approve city funding for pickle ball court resurfacing and expansion project

---

### **Background Summary:**

Tyler Mitchell, our park and rec director, has applied for a \$20,000 grant from MinnTex to resurface and expand the current pickle ball courts. The current courts have a good number of cracks running through them and are not regulation size. With the planned improvements, our courts would be sanctioned and we could participate in leagues and tournaments that are sanctioned. The expansion would not only make the courts sanctioned, it will make them safer as well since there will be more distance to the fence around the court. The estimate received from Heartland Asphalt for this work is \$36,500. With the \$20,000 grant, the city's share of this project would be \$16,500. We plan to utilize the one day borrowing for this project that was originally earmarked for re-siding the Wildwood clubhouse.

We recommend approval of this resolution.
