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## AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY

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**Subject: Discuss 2020 Drainage Improvement Project acceptance**

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**Background Summary:**

Kamm Excavating was the General Contractor for the 2020 Drainage Improvement Project. The work has been finished, and the Council can accept the completed project. The City Council awarded the bid and approved contract and bonds at the August 24, 2020 City Council meeting.

This project was designed to help improve three (3) separate drainage issues. The project includes a storm sewer extension in the 1100 block of South Grand (near Comet Bowl), a diversion ditch in the 500 and 600 blocks of J Street, and site drainage at the Art Center building.

The South Grand Storm Sewer Extension placed intakes on South Grand near O'Reilly's auto parts store to intercept some of the surface water in the street gutter to help eliminate the ponding issues at the low point. The J Street Area Diversion constructed a drainage swale to direct surface water away from the houses on the east side of J Street and into the storm sewer system. The Art Center Drainage Improvement provided a new and deeper outlet for the drain at the handicap entrance and additional grading and storm sewer directed surface water away from the Art Center Building.

The project was completed at a total cost of \$241,131.00 which is 3.8% more than the original bid amount of \$232,220.00. The additional cost was due to a conflict with a gas main and the new storm sewer on South Grand Avenue and some additional storm sewer pipe on the J Street site.

We plan to have a resolution for your consideration accepting the project and authorizing final payment at next week's City Council meeting.
