AGREEMENT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE

The City of Charles City, Iowa (the City) is hosting RAGBRAI on July 28, 2022, and needs the assistance of law enforcement officers from other municipalities (Participating Municipalities) during this event.

For the purpose of facilitating such assistance, it is necessary to define the responsibilities and liabilities of the City and the Participating Municipality during the period that this assistance is provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AGREED BY THE CITY AND THE PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Assistance Provided/Employment Status of Law Enforcement Officers. The Participating Municipality will provide the services of _____ law enforcement officers to the City for the period from ____ o'clock a.m. on the _____ day of July, 2022, to _____ o'clock a.m./p.m. on the _____ day of July, 2022. These officers will, during this period, act under the direct supervision of the police chief of the City but will nevertheless remain employees of the Participating Municipality and will receive their compensation from the Participating Municipality for these services. The law enforcement officers provided by the Participating Municipality will be bringing and using equipment, a firearm, uniform and badge provided by the Participating Municipality for use during the period stated above.
- 2. Reimbursement for Assistance. The City will reimburse the Participating Municipality for the compensation paid to its law enforcement officers who provide their services to the City under the terms of this agreement. Participating Municipalities shall provide an invoice to the City Clerk of the City following the conclusion of RAGBRAI and this invoice will be paid with other bills received by the City Clerk.
- 3. <u>Workers Compensation Insurance</u>. The Participating Municipality shall be responsible for maintaining workers compensation insurance coverage for its employees during the period that they provide services to the City.
- 4. <u>Statutory Basis for Contract</u>. This agreement is executed under the authority of §28E.12 of the Iowa Code and shall become effective upon approval by the City Council (governing body) of each party to this contract.
- 5. <u>Termination</u>. This agreement shall automatically terminate on July 29, 2022, at 5:00 p.m.
