REPLACE SE TRAFFIC LIGHT AT THE CORNER OF S. MAIN & GILBERT ST.

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Background Summary:

The Southeast traffic light at the corner of S Main St & Gilbert St is in rough condition. It is sitting too close to the street and has obviously been hit many times. Please see attached photos of the base and pole. We have a quote from K&W to install a new base. The quote includes moving the base of the traffic pole 2' to the South and rewire the new pole at the new base.

The new pole will be galvanized steel like the ones that K&W installed on the IDOT project last year. This pole will look different from the others at the intersection but will not need to be painted/repainted.

I did request a quote from Perry Novak and did not receive a quote back from them.
