Spring Cleanup Drop off

April 28th through May 7th

- “Truckload” Drop Off Event – Shaw Avenue Dump
(No added fee)

-OR-

- Pre-Scheduled Bulky Item Curbside Pickup

(Must contact LJP/Jendro Sanitation (641-228-3525) to arrange pickup; fees apply)

Drop Off - Guidelines

- Drop off of items will need to be taken to the Shaw Avenue Dump – located at the leaf/brush dump off of Clark Street. (300 Shaw Avenue)
 - Each property that receives a city utility bill will be allowed one trip (“truckload”) to the Shaw Avenue dump to place items in large dumpsters. There will be separate dumpsters for garbage, metals and cardboard. Items must be placed in those specific dumpsters.
 - Proof of residency will need to be provided at the time of drop off (utility bill stub or similar proof of residency)
 - Dump will be open from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. each day of the 10-day event

Pre-Scheduled Bulky Item curbside pickup

- LJP/Jendro Sanitation will pick up bulky items curbside for a fee during the week of Spring Cleanup: To use this service please contact LJP/Jendro Sanitation at **641-228-3525 no later than May 2nd** to schedule a pickup. You will be required to submit payment prior to pick up. Below is list of some of the bulky items and the pickup charge:
 - Carpeting (per yard)-**\$15**; Grill (no propane tanks)-**\$20**
 - Mattress or Box Spring; Furniture – recliner, table, dresser, sofa (non-Sleeper) and etc.-**\$25**
 - Sleeper Sofa-**\$40**
 - Other Items (per yard)-**\$15**

Temporary Dumpster Rental Delivered to property (max 7 days; first come first served basis)
Sizes/Pricing per dump– 2(yd)=**\$110**; 4(yd)=**\$135**; 12(yd)=**\$400**; 30(yd)=**\$600**

- Volunteer Pick Up – If you are unable to take items to the dump; there are community service groups that are offering individual assistance. Contact City Hall to inquire about this option.

-OVER-

Acceptable items for drop off include:

- Furniture & household items
- Minor home remodeling debris – must be bagged or bundled (cardboard boxes disposed in separate dumpster)
- Paint cans containing dry paints – with lid removed
- ****NEW****- Car tires – limited to four (4) passenger car tires per address (no large truck, ag/implement tires accepted)

Non-Acceptable items in with trash for drop off include:

- Major Household Appliances, “White goods”, Televisions or Computer Equipment
- Corrugated Cardboard Co-Mingled (must be placed in separate specified dumpster)
- Batteries
- Shingles, tar paper or construction debris.
- Landscape Waste: grass clippings, leaves, tree limbs or brush
 - (2022 Brush curbside pickup dates: May 9th, June 20th, October 17th)
 - **LJP/Jendro offering additional scheduled pickup of bulky items on these dates as well**
 - (2022 Leaf pickup dates: October 24th & November 14th)
- Hazardous Waste Materials: liquid paint, solvents, pesticides or herbicides.
- Sharps/Needles/medical waste

What not to do:

- Do not place non-acceptable items in the dumpsters
- Do not place items curbside unless you’ve scheduled a pickup
- No items from outside City limits will be accepted
- Items in excess of the allowed amount are subject to additional charge
- Do not place televisions, major appliances “white goods” or computer equipment in dumpsters

DISPOSAL OF MAJOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

MidAmerican Energy’s Appliance Recycling program offers rebates to remove qualifying appliances. If your old refrigerator, freezer or window air conditioner is in working condition, you may qualify to have it picked up, properly disposed of and receive a rebate.
